Weigh in: Remember picture id for weigh in.

There will be decentral weigh-in on Thursday the 24th of February between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm at the following locations:

Rødovre, Højnæsvej 61, 2610 Rødovre – Responsible Heidi Atiadevey.

Esbjerg, Sportsvej 21, 6705 Esbjerg Ø – Responsible David Coupar

Skanderborg, Regnbuevænget 5, 8660 Skanderborg – Responsible – Carsten Stigers

Weigh-in for teams coming from abroad will be on Friday the 25th of February at the venue in Esbjerg

The team must have a responsible team leader, who is in charge of the teams weigh in. The team leader may be another person than the one registered to DTaF. It is the team leader responsibility, that all the teams fighters is present and ready for the weigh in, when it is the teams turn to enter. Only the team leader may be present at the weigh in. The team leader may appoint a person of the opposite sex, to assist, e.g. the team leader is a man and asks a woman to assist at weigh in of women. The team leader shall inform the Tournament director about this. Children and Cadets have one attempt at the weight. If they are not in weight, they will be moved automatically. There is no extra fee here. Seniors and veterans have two attempts within the time limit. If the fighter does not keep the registered weight class, he or she can move the weight class by paying an additional fee corresponding to the registration fee. Children and Cadet Athletes who are alone in their weight class after weighing will automatically be transferred to the next weight class. **Unless it is clearly stated at the weigh-in if they do not wish to move up.** At international events, the WT- rules are applied. The fighter may only wear briefs/panties, girls may wear bra, yet the senior fighter may be naked according to the WT rules. Children, Cadets and Juniors must be weighed with underwear and 100 grams of variation is allowed. If instructions, from the DTaF responsible person, is not met, the competitor/team leader will be disqualified/ expelled and the incident will be reported to Tournament director. No new applications will be accepted at the weigh in, and no agreements about change of application can be made with the person conducting the weigh-in; this can only be done with the Tournament director.

You have to have the entry fee paid, as well as to make sure that you have registered your Report of insurance and liability (please check: <http://www.taekwondo.dk/myfightbook.asp>) to be registered at the weigh in!

Clubs who need to pay at the weigh in, need to bring the exact amount of money in Danish Kroner. We do not guarantee to have change!
